RESERVATION REQUESTS

10 is the minimum amount of seats that may be requested for all student matinee performances (5 students MINIMUM). Requests that do not meet these requirements will not be considered. All reservation requests submitted online will be reviewed individually. Once reviewed, requests will either be APPROVED or WAITLISTED in a timely manner. Once approved, your school/organization will receive a link to pay for seats online. Checks are also accepted may be made out to Colorado Ballet and sent to the address below.

FINAL NUMBERS/CANCELLATION POLICY

Once your seats have been approved and confirmed, you are responsible for payment (unless performance designated as free of charge). If your group's numbers change, please let Cassie Wilson know as soon as possible. If your group cannot attend, please contact Cassie Wilson immediately. <u>Final numbers and/or cancellations are due three weeks prior</u> to the performance date. After this date, you are responsible for payment on the original number of seats reserved.

PAYMENT

<u>Payment is due at least two weeks prior</u> to the performance date, unless otherwise noted. If you cannot pay online via the link sent to you, please make checks payable to Colorado Ballet and mail to:

TICKETS

<u>There are no tickets for this event</u>. Your group name will be on a list, and the number of seats approved will be indicated on the seating map each usher and staff volunteer will be given. Therefore, it is essential that individual families within your group <u>know the group name</u> in order to be admitted to the theater if they are arriving separately.

LOCATION AND PARKING

- The Ellie Caulkins Opera House is located downtown at 14th Street and Curtis Street. Exact address is 1385 Curtis Street, Denver, CO 80204.
- Parking for private vehicles is available in the Performing Arts Complex, for a fee.
- Bus parking instructions attached.

ARRIVAL

- Groups may begin arriving and lining up in the common area in front of the theater 30-45 minutes before the show. Doors to the lobby will open 15-30 minutes before the show. The house will open 15 minutes before the show.
- Ushers and Colorado Ballet staff will be equipped with seating maps to direct groups toward their seats.

PERFORMANCE

The Student Matinee performances are final dress rehearsals. Therefore, The Artistic Staff will occasionally make audible comments to the dancers, or, more rarely, even stop the performance to make changes. This enables students to have a "behind the scenes" look into the production.

INTERMISSION AND LUNCHES

- There will be one (or two, depending on the performance) 20 minute intermission(s) for restroom breaks, snacks/lunches, etc. Absolutely no food or drink allowed inside the theater! Students in violation of this request will be asked to leave the theater with a chaperone.
- You can leave packed lunches in the lobby while you enjoy the performance.
- Performance run time can be found in the study guide.
