



Donor Guide: Enterprise Zone Tax Credit

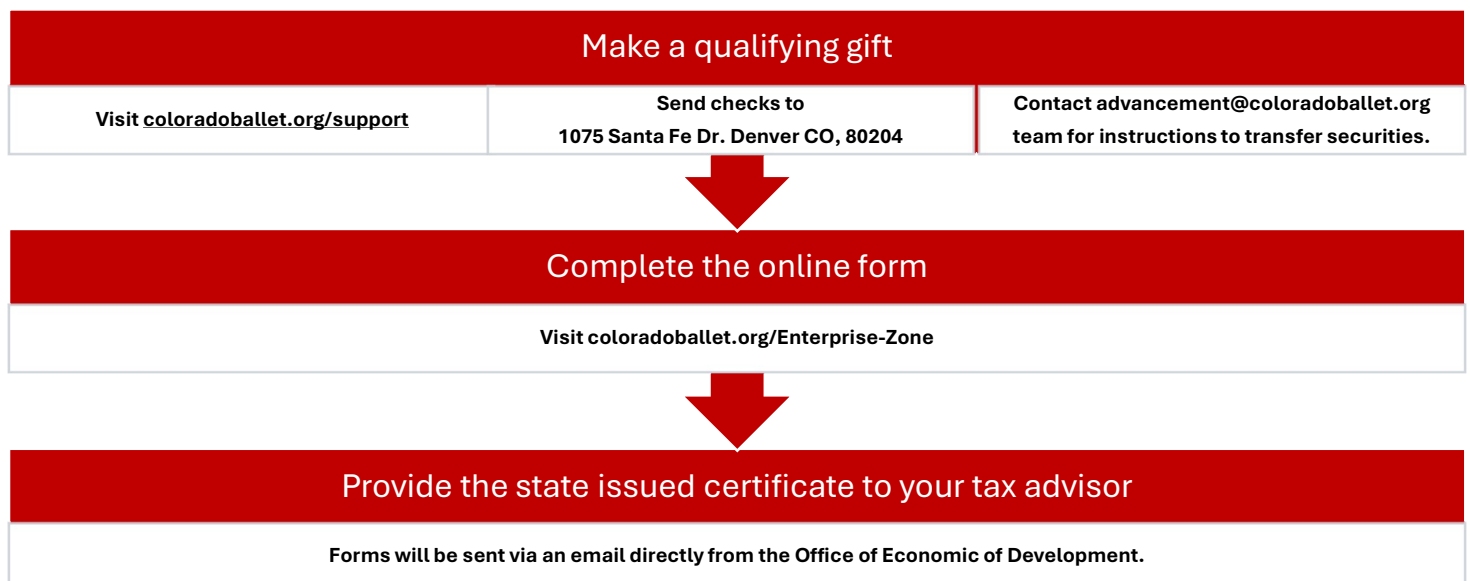
The Colorado Enterprise Zone program was created to assist economically distressed areas by offering income tax credits to non-profits and their donors. The Colorado Ballet Armstrong Center for Dance is in one of these Enterprise Zones and therefore your gift could receive additional tax benefits.

Colorado residents who make a qualifying gift of \$250 or more to Colorado Ballet may be eligible to receive a generous tax credit of 25% on cash donations and 12.5% on in-kind and stock gifts. The maximum annual credit for cash gifts is \$100,000. In-kind and stock gifts have a maximum credit of \$50,000. Any excess credit may be carried forward for up to 5 years.
